Talking of chefs, we have a great team lined up to present our cookery demonstrations and these will take place throughout the afternoon. Bruce will be bringing accomplished instrumentalists along with him and what starts as a supper will end in with a foot stompin' cascade of traditional Scottish music and dance.
